#### **IGUAÇU FALLS:** *02 days / 01 night*

Also spelled Iguassú, Cataratas del Iguazú in Spanish or Cataratas do Iguaçu in Portuguese is a series of cataracts on the Iguaçu River, 14 miles (23 km) above its confluence with the Alto (Upper) Paraná River, at the Argentina-Brazil border. The Falls resemble an elongated horseshoe that extends for 1.7 miles (2.7 km) - nearly three times wider than Niagara Falls in North America and significantly greater than the width of Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe, Africa. Numerous rocky and wooded

islands on the edge of the escarpment over which the Iguaçu River plunges divide the Falls into some 275 separate waterfalls or cataracts, varying between 200 and 269 feet (60 and 82 meters) in height. UNESCO has granted World Heritage status to the park.



The package of services includes private transfer airport/hotel/airport in Iguassu Falls; 1 night at **Belmond Hotel das Cataratas** (deluxe hotel), in a superior room including tax and breakfast; guided tour to the Falls at Brazilian side and "Macuco Safari" boat tour. The Belmond Hotel is the only hotel located just in front of the Falls at Brazilian side. Assistance in English (other languages upon request). Tour to the Argentinean side of the Falls and/or to the Itaipu Hydro-Electric Plant are available upon request. There is risk of getting wet during the Macuco Safari Tour.

#### **MANAUS & AMAZON RAIN FOREST:** *04 days / 03 nights*

Manaus, was one of the first cities in the country to have electric power, and it reached its economic peak with the rubber boom; in such period, the rubber barons invested in exuberant architectural monuments, like The Opera House and the floating harbor. At that time Manaus was known as "Paris of South America".

The point where the Negro river meets the Solimões river leads to a spectacular phenomenon: the **Meeting of the Waters**, where the black waters of Negro river and the creamy colored waters of Rio Solimões river flow side by side, without mixing for 2 to 4 miles, and then, finally, they merge to form the Amazon River.

The package of services includes 1 night at **Hotel Tropical Manaus** – deluxe hotel, in a standard room with breakfast and tax; 2 nights at **Juma Amazon Lodge** in a standard bungalow and full board basis; regular transfer airport/hotel in Manaus; regular transfer Manaus/ Juma Lodge/ Manaus by ground transportation plus boat transportation passing by the **Meeting of the Waters Point**; 3 hours private tour in Manaus visiting the Amazonas Opera House, Rio Negro and Provincial Palaces, Public Market; local tours at Juma Amazon Lodge, such as "crocodile" spotting, walking tour through the forest, visit to native's house, sunrise tour and canoe tour on the river, according to the planned activities organized by the lodge's team during your stay. ## ANAVILHANAS ECOLOGICAL PARK: 04 days / 03 nights

Anavilhanas is a National Park and a Brazilian conservation unit for the full protection of the Nature in the Amazonas state and in the Rain Amazon forest. It is an archipelago with hundreds of islands in the Negro River, within an outer perimeter of 380km. Located 180km far from Manaus in the deep Amazon Forest, the **Anavilhanas Jungle Lodge** is much more than a simply place to stay: it is an opportunity to be really in touch with the Nature of that part of the World.

The package of services includes 3 nights at **Anavilhanas Jungle Lodge** in a comfortable cottage and full board basis; regular round trip ground transportation to the Manaus' Airport (2h30min); local tours at the Anavilhanas Jungle lodge such as nocturnal sightseeing at the archipelago; visit to Amazonian Dolphins and art parlors in Novo Airão; recreational piranha fishing; walking tour through the forest; visit to natives house; sunrise tour and canoe tour on the river, according to the planned activities organized by the lodge's team during your stay. ## AMAZON CRUISE

The **IBEROSTAR CRUISE** includes lodging in all inclusive basis (meals, welcome cocktail, all snacks, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, guided activities and excursions at the stops); round trip **regular transportation** in Manaus and assistance in English (other languages upon request). **Two itineraries are available**

Entertainment during the cruise includes field trips, regional dance classes, fishing and ecological classes where participants are taught about the native fauna and flora. There are also motorboat excursions through the local lakes of Igarapós and Igarapés. Evening activity includes live music and theme parties.



## BONITO: 05 days / 04 nights

Bonito - located in the state of Mato Grosso do Sul, has as main attractions: prehistoric caves, waterfalls with crystalline waters, natural aquariums, and archeology sites. Registered by the National Historical Patrimony, the Cave of Nossa Senhora Aparecida and the Cave of Lago Azul (with a deep and unbelievably blue lake inside) are well worth your visit.

The package of services includes regular transportation Campo Grande Airport (CGR) / Bonito / Campo Grande Airport (280 Km); 4 nights at **Pousada Olho D'Agua** – tourist class hotel, in a standard room including breakfast and tax; transfer and visit to Lago Azul Cave, Parque das Cachoeiras (waterfalls park) without meals, Rio da Prata (flotation) including lunch and Rio Sucuri (flotation) including lunch. Assistance in English during the local tours (other languages upon request).



## FERNANDO DE NORONHA: 04 days / 03 nights

Fernando de Noronha is an isolated group of volcanic islands located in the South Equatorial Atlantic, approximately 340 miles from Recife, Pernambuco State. The main islands are the visible part of a range of submerged mountains. Consisting of 21 islands, islets and rocks of volcanic origin, the main island makes up 91% of the total area.

The climate is tropical, has 2 well-defined seasons: the **rain season** (March to August), and the **dry season** (rest of the year). There are many beaches to choose from in the island. Some are better adapted to diving, others to swimming, contemplation, surfing, etc. In general, the beaches found on the protected side of the main island are ideal for diving and swimming during the months of April through November, due to the extremely calm sea.

The package of services includes round trip flights between Recife and Fernando de Noronha in economy class; round trip airport transportation in Fernando de Noronha Island; 3 nights at **Pousada Dolphin** or similar – tourist class, in a standard room, including breakfast and tax; walking guided **Historical Tour**, boat tour to **Dolphins Bay** and **4x4 tour** through the Island. Assistance in English (other languages upon request).





### **PANTANAL:** 04 days / 03 nights

Located in the central region of Brazil and one of the biggest sedimentation plains in the World, Pantanal takes about 140,000 km<sup>2</sup> - and it also spreads out to the neighboring countries - Argentina, Bolivia and Paraguay. This true ecological patrimony is the habitat of countless species of mammals and reptiles, birds and fishes, has exuberant vegetation and due to the permanent movement of shapes, colors and sounds it is one of the most beautiful

live shows on Earth.

The package of services includes meeting at Campo Grande airport and private round trip transfer to the Fazenda San Francisco (230 km), a rustic and comfortable lodge; 3 nights in a standard room and full board basis; local guided tours such as horseback riding, nocturnal outings, trekking, boat tours, "piranha" fishing, birds watching and "crocodile" (caiman) spotting. Tours will be planned by the lodge's team according to the weather and length of the stay. Assistance in English, except during the airport transfers (other languages upon request).



### **RIO DE JANEIRO:** 04 days / 03 nights

Known as "Cidade Maravilhosa" (Marvelous City), the luxuriant greenery contrasts with thousands of modern buildings and a bustling metropolis. The city brings together one of the country's busiest nights and cultural lives, the world's most well known Carnival and Samba schools. Rio de Janeiro also offers its white sand beaches such as "Copacabana" and "Ipanema", names that are recognized all over the world.

The package of services includes private transfer airport/hotel/airport in Rio de Janeiro; 3 nights at **Windsor Leme Hotel** - first class hotel at Leme Beach (next to Copacabana Beach), in a superior room including tax and breakfast; full day (8 hours without meals) private tour visiting Corcovado, Sugar Loaf, Tijuca Forest and beaches up to São Conrado; half day private tour the downtown area; tickets for Corcovado and Sugar Loaf. Assistance in English (other languages upon request).

### **SALVADOR:** 03 days / 02 nights

Salvador was founded in 1549 and remained its first capital until 1763. For 300 years it was the most important city of the South Atlantic and the capital of the Portuguese Colony in America. Nowadays, Salvador is the third largest city of Brazil and one of the most valuable historical, architectural and cultural centers of our country. On the streets of the Historical City Center, full of Portuguese Colonial houses, protected by UNESCO as Cultural Heritage of Humankind, it is easy to see the opulence and power of the past. Mysticism and great

musicality are part of its people's strong personality. The African influence dominates religious and cultural manifestations.

The package of services includes private transfer airport / hotel / airport in Salvador; 2 nights at **Bahia Othon** - a first class hotel in a premium room including tax and breakfast; half day private historical tour; half day private sightseeing tour; regular tour by night with folk-show and dinner - international and regional food (beverage not included). Assistance in English (other languages upon request).



### **RECIFE & OLINDA:** 04 days / 03 nights

Recife - Capital of Pernambuco State, was built as a sugar cane port city and due to its numerous waterways, has been called "Venice of Brazil". Olinda - the ancient and historical city near Recife, was founded in 1537 and was designated by UNESCO as a World Heritage city. Porto de Galinhas (chicken port) - 70Km far away from Recife, was the gateway for slaves brought to work on the sugar cane plantations and nowadays is one of the most famous tourist destinations on the Brazilian coast.

The package of services includes private transfer airport/hotel/airport in Recife; 3 nights at **Radisson Recife Hotel** - first class hotel at Boa Viagem Beach, in a standard room including tax and breakfast; full day private tour in Recife and Olinda including stop for lunch (meal not included); tour by night to the Old Recife (dinner not included); full day private tour to Porto de Galinhas (70Km - lunch not included). Assistance in English - other languages upon request.



## **BRASILIA:** *02 days / 01 night*

Capital of Brazil - located on the Central Plateau, at the heart of the country – Brasilia was planned, designed and built in 3 years and inaugurated on April 21<sup>st</sup>, 1960. Its master plan was conceived by Lucio Costa, and its major buildings were designed by Oscar Niemeyer. Known all over the world for the lightness of its architecture and innovative urban design, in just a little more than 3 decades, Brasilia has won UNESCO's recognition as "heritage of Humanity".

The package of services includes private transportation airport / hotel / airport in Brasília; 1 night at **Comfort Suites Hotel** – first class hotel, in standard room with tax and breakfast; full day tour with lunch, visiting the main spots in the city, including architectural landmarks. Assistance in English (other languages upon request).
